

**Haber, Gottfried, ao.Univ.-Prof. MMag. Dr., Associate Professor,  
Economics Department, Klagenfurt University, Austria**

Gottfried Haber was born in Vienna on December 3, 1972. He studied both, Economics and Business Administration at the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration, where he also got his PhD in economic sciences summa cum laude in June 2000. His „Habilitation“ was on economic multi-agent systems. Since 1997, Gottfried Haber has been Professor of Economics at the Klagenfurt University. He has published several scientific articles and papers and given a large number of talks and lectures (also at Stanford and Cambridge), e.g. as senior lecturer at the Pädagogische Akademie des Bundes in Vienna, at the Department of Banking at the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration, at the Fachhochschule Krems, and within several post-gradual programmes.

He is also Executive Director of the METIS Institute in Vienna and Head of the CEE Competence Center Carinthia. Gottfried Haber conducted several projects, e.g. for UNIDO, the Government of Slovenia, the Government of El Salvador, the Austrian Chamber of Commerce, the Austrian Federal Chancellery, the European Commission, World Bank, the Austrian National Bank, the Austrian Federal Ministry of Economic Affairs, the Austrian Chamber of Labor, and several other institutions.

Since 2008, he has been a member of the supervisory board of the Carinthian Development Agency and the Carinthian Tourism Holding. Since 2009, he has been the chairman of the Economic Policy Council of the Government of Carinthia and Chief Financial Markets Officer for the Government of Carinthia.

Research topics include among others: European Monetary Union and enlargement, international economics, economic policy, public finance, quantitative methods, applied econometrics, empirical studies, money and finance, banking, risk management, general management, and operations research.
